



Mini (Fingerless) Mitts



These fingerless mitts are perfect for small amounts of worsted weight yarn—and for small hands. Easy to knit and easy to wear!

SIZE

Child's Small (2-4yr),
Child's Medium (5-8yr)

GAUGE

24 sts = 4" in stockinette (in the round)

MATERIALS

Worsted or heavy-weight worsted yarn
(less than 50gms)
Size 5 DPNs
tapestry needle
small length of waste yarn

PATTERN

CO 30 (34). Join.

Work 8 (10) rows 1 x 1 rib.

Work stockinette for 15 (20) rows.
(Adapt number of stockinette rows if necessary to increase/decrease height of portion of mitten below thumb.)

Knit first 4 (5) onto waste yarn.
Move these stitches back to left needle.

Continue with main yarn. Work
stockinette for 4 (8) rows.

(Adapt number if necessary for height of portion of mitten from thumb up to go as far up child's fingers as desired. Mitten can be tried on being careful to keep thumb inside mitten.)

Work 5 rows 1 x 1 rib.

BO in rib.

THUMB:

Carefully remove waste yarn and put live stitches on two DPNs, rearranging as follows: 4 (5) for top of thumb on one needle and 4 (5) for bottom of thumb on second needle.

Beginning with bottom needle, knit 4 (5).
With next needle, pick up and knit 2 stitches along side. With same needle, knit 2 (3). With next needle, knit 2 (2).
Pick up and knit 2 stitches along side. 12 (14) total stitches.

Work stockinette for 3 (5) rounds.

BO loosely.

Finishing:

Weave ends on inside to secure.
